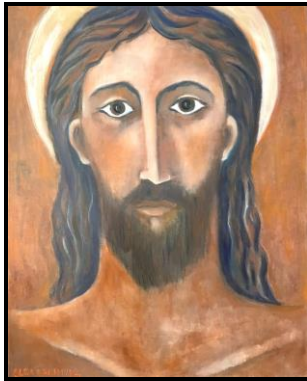

GOSPEL READING John 18:33-37

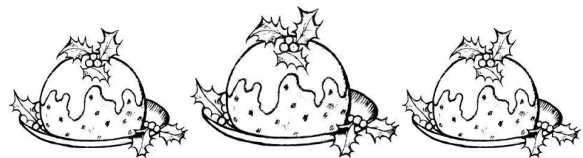

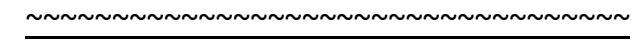
POST COMMUNION COLLECT
